

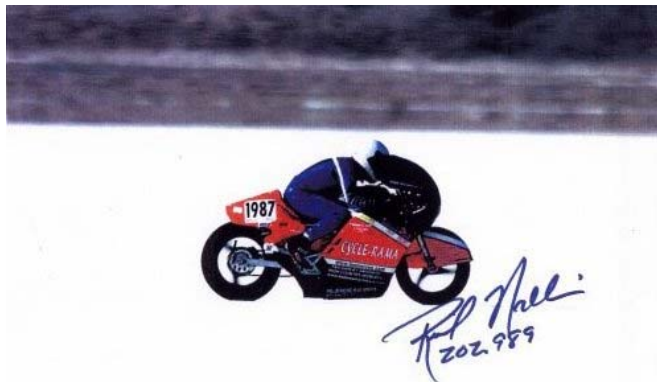
COLDfire

Record mark by
a staggering
32%***

Bonneville Salt Flats, October 18, 2002

Richard Nallin broke the worlds motorcycle speed record driving a 1650 ccmps Harley Engine to a record speed of 326.67 kmh, and earlier achieved a trial lap speed of 335kmh.

The previous record of 252 kmh was shattered by over 30% and this was the first 1650 cc engine to ever achieve this speed.



The engine and all working components were treated with a specific COLDFIRE THERMAL CYCLING PROCESS developed by Frank Masyada at their facility in Largo Florida.
